

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRISCO, COLLIN AND DENTON COUNTIES, TEXAS, AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 16-11-93 TO DESIGNATE FOUR (4) ELECTION PRECINCTS FOR THE FEBRUARY 18, 2017 SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF FRISCO, COLLIN AND DENTON COUNTIES, TEXAS, AS ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL; AUTHORIZING ALL NECESSARY ACTIONS RELATING THERETO; AND PROVIDING A SAVINGS/REPEALING CLAUSE, SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, City Council of the City of Frisco, Texas ("City Council") previously adopted Ordinance No. 16-11-93, which designated four (4) voting precincts for the special election to be held within the City of Frisco, Collin and Denton Counties, Texas ("Frisco") on January 14, 2017, for the purpose of filling a vacancy in the office of City Council, Place No. 1, resulting from the holder of that office announcing his candidacy for mayor of Frisco; and

WHEREAS, after the adoption of Ordinance No. 16-11-93, the Collin County Elections Administrator and the Denton County Elections Administrator stated that they cannot provide full services to administer the special election on January 14, 2017 because of inadequate staffing and the unavailability of necessary resources; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has investigated and determined that it is therefore necessary to amend Ordinance No. 16-11-93, to modify the date of the election for which the four (4) voting precincts were previously designated, as set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRISCO, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: Findings Incorporated. The findings set forth above are incorporated into the body of this Ordinance as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2: Amendment to Section 2 (Designation of Four (4) Election Precincts for January 14, 2017 Special Election) of Ordinance No. 16-11-93. Section 2 (Designation of Four (4) Election Precincts for January 14, 2017 Special Election) of Ordinance No. 16-11-93 is hereby amended as follows:

"SECTION 2: Designation of Four (4) Election Precincts for February 18, 2017 Special Election. For the February 18, 2017 special election, four (4) election precincts are hereby designated, as depicted in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes, and described as follows:

1. City Precinct 1 consists of those portions of Denton County Precinct Nos. 1028, 1029, 1030, 1031, 1036, 1040 and 2028 which are located inside the Frisco city limits.
2. City Precinct 2 consists of those portions of Collin County Precinct Nos. 30, 92, 101, 111, 117, 118, 127, 146 and 177 which are located inside the Frisco city limits.
3. City Precinct 3 consists of that portion of Collin County Precinct Nos. 87, 134 and 212 which are located inside the Frisco city limits.
4. City Precinct 4 consists of that portion of Denton County Precinct Nos. 1032, 1033, 1034 and 1035 which are located inside the Frisco city limits.


SECTION 3: Severability. Should any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional and/or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is expressly provided that any and all remaining portions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, clause and phrase thereof regardless of whether any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases may be declared unconstitutional and/or invalid.

SECTION 4: Savings/Repealing. Ordinance No. 16-11-93 shall remain in full force and effect, save and except as amended by this or any other ordinance. All provisions of any ordinance or resolution in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent they are in conflict. Any remaining portion of conflicting ordinances or resolutions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.


