



Q. Where can I get traffic count data for the City of Frisco?


The City of Frisco counts the traffic on every major roadway every two to three years. This traffic count data is available at <http://maps.friscotexas.gov>. On the top menu, click on the Common Maps icon and select "Traffic Counts."



Once you zoom into an area you can see numbers on each road which represent the total daily traffic in both directions on that segment of road. (Each road is shown as two colored lines representing each direction of travel, but the same number is shown on both lines.)



Click the Identify icon at the top of the page and then click on a colored link to find out more details such as the date of the traffic count, the amount of traffic in each direction, and any historical traffic counts (if available).



Special Cases:

DNT & Dallas Parkway - Even though the Dallas Parkway frontage roads are widely separated, they are each shown with the same number (which represents the total traffic in both directions). The website does not show the traffic volumes on the main lanes of the Dallas North Tollway, for which you would need to contact the North Texas Tollway Authority (www.ntta.org).

SRT & SH 121 – The southwest-bound SH 121 frontage road is in the City of Frisco while the northeast-bound SH 121 frontage road is in the City of Plano. The number shown on the southwest-bound SH 121 frontage road only represents the traffic in the southwest-bound direction. Contact the City of Plano for traffic counts on the northeast-bound frontage road. Contact the North Texas Tollway Authority (www.ntta.org) for the traffic volumes on the main lanes of the Sam Rayburn Tollway.

Preston Road at SH 121 – The traffic volumes on the Preston Road overpass are shown separately from the traffic volumes on the Preston Road frontage roads. In a rare exception, the traffic volumes on the Preston Road frontage roads are shown separately (one number for the northbound frontage road and one number for the southbound frontage road).
