



BIRTHDAY PARTIES- Safety Presentation Lesson

We will help you host by providing your party guests a tour of the station along with its firefighting equipment. We'll also share some fire prevention and safety tips wrapped up in FUN!

These are the safety topics you may learn about.

Exit Drills In The Home

Learn about creating an “exit plan” for your family so you can get out of your home safely in an emergency. Partygoers learn the importance of finding “two ways out” of every room; crawling through smoke; and designating a “*meeting place*” outside the home. Since “practice makes perfect” partygoers are encouraged to practice their exit drills twice each year!

Stop, Drop, Cover and Roll

Kids and parents will learn what to do should their clothes catch on fire. Learn about different protective measures that can be taken to prevent clothes from igniting and the sources of heat which can cause their clothes to catch on fire. Kids will also have the opportunity to practice the act of Stop, Drop and Roll.

Move to the Right

Move to the Right for Sirens and Lights. Firefighters will explain that when there is an approaching emergency vehicle, motorist should safely move to the right.

Firefighter Gear/Clothing

Watch a firefighter dress up in their firefighting gear. Kids will see that firefighters might seem scary looking in bunker gear, but they'll learn that the firefighter is there to help.
